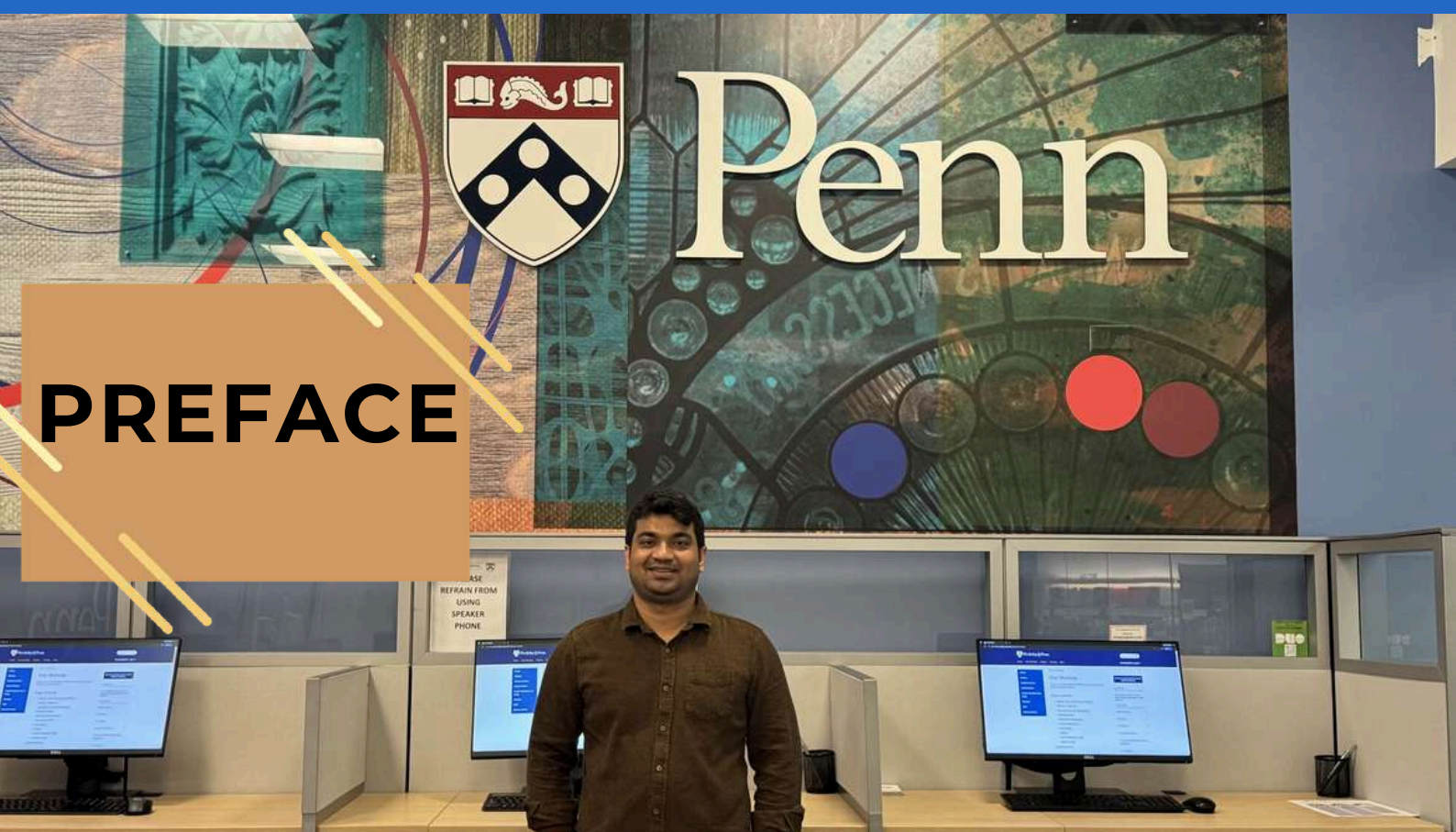

# THE SPARK OF LEADERSHIP (2008–2017) – EARLY CAREER IN YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

Chennai (2017–2019), a program fully funded through a merit scholarship by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India. This period was marked by extensive field-based training, including rural immersion camps (Puliyur and Oragadam villages, 2018), community health and social sensitization programs in Rajasthan (2018), and participation in National Service Scheme (NSS) Swachh Bharat initiatives, where he combined practical action with social research.

Mr. Niraj Kumar Singh's journey in youth development is deeply rooted in both academic preparation and practical engagement in community initiatives. His foundational education began with a Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) from Jai Prakash University, Saran, Bihar (2010–2013), where he cultivated analytical skills and a commitment to civic responsibility. During this period, he actively participated in voluntary blood donation drives and voter awareness campaigns, reflecting an early dedication to social welfare and civic participation. Following his undergraduate studies, he pursued a Master of Social Work (M.S.W.) in Youth & Community Development at the Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development (RGNIYD),

Alongside formal education, Mr. Singh engaged in multiple workshops and professional certifications that strengthened his skills in social work, research methodology, counseling, and community mobilization. Notably, he participated in the National Youth Corps Training Camp organized by Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (2016), the Street Theatre Workshop at Alternative Media Centre, Chennai (2017), and various research methodology and SPSS workshops at RGNIYD (2018). These experiences honed his capacity for leadership, program design, and community engagement. By the end of 2017.

Mr. Singh had not only established a strong educational foundation but had also amassed rich experiential learning through grassroots interventions, volunteer engagements, and skill-based training, laying the groundwork for his trajectory as a youth leader and social innovator.

# THE SPARK OF LEADERSHIP (2018–2025) – EARLY CAREER IN YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

From 2018 onward, Mr. Niraj Kumar Singh's journey transitioned from national community engagement to international youth development leadership. Building upon his training at RGNIYD, he initiated and led youth empowerment and educational access programs across South and Southeast Asia, including Malaysia, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Cambodia, Vietnam, Laos, and Thailand, reaching nearly 10,000 young people through leadership workshops, life-skills training, and social action camps. His initiatives promoted education continuity, digital literacy, and youth participation, forming sustainable youth clubs and self-help groups that became models for community-led transformation.

By 2019, his contributions earned global recognition through multiple international awards in Cambodia, Vietnam, Laos, and Myanmar for social innovation and youth empowerment. His ability to bridge local issues with global frameworks strengthened networks among universities, youth-led organizations, and intergovernmental bodies. During this period, he also engaged in collaborative initiatives supported by USAID and World Vision, mobilizing cross-sectoral partnerships to promote inclusive education and health awareness.

Following his global field engagements, Mr. Singh expanded his leadership into research, training, and academic excellence. Between 2020 and 2023, he served in development and academic institutions across India, mentoring over 3,000 social work students and coordinating large-scale public health programs, including the USAID/JSI-supported COVID-19 vaccination campaigns that reached over 2.5 million people in Jharkhand, Odisha, and Telangana. His work received multiple recognitions, including national and state-level appreciation from the Department of Health and Family Welfare and the National Pride Award (2022).

**Youth Event Convened by the Chair of the UNGA Third Committee—Building Solutions Together for an Inclusive Future:** Niraj Kumar Singh participated as a youth delegate at the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) Third Committee Youth Event on “Building Solutions Together for an Inclusive Future,” held on October 10, 2025, at the United Nations Headquarters, New York. Representing India, he joined global leaders, diplomats, and youth advocates in discussions on education, social inclusion, and youth empowerment. Organised by the Third Committee Secretariat in collaboration with the Major Group for Children and Youth (MGCY), the event aimed to amplify youth-led perspectives on global social development and strengthen intergenerational dialogue. It coincided

with the 80th Anniversary of the UN and preparations for the World Summit for Social Development (WSSD2). Through interactive sessions and policy exchanges, Niraj contributed to shaping discussions on inclusive governance and multilateral cooperation, reaffirming the vital role of young people in advancing sustainable and equitable global progress.

During his visit to the United Nations Headquarters in New York City, Niraj Kumar Singh engaged in an insightful discussion with Mr. Felipe Paullier, Assistant Secretary-General on Youth Affairs, United Nations Youth Office, centred on advancing youth development in India and across the globe. Their exchange brought home the value of inclusive and participatory youth policies that align with the UN’s Pact for the Future and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

This interaction not only deepened Niraj’s understanding of the critical role of community engagement in educational transformation but also reinforced his commitment to advancing equitable, participatory, and locally grounded approaches in international educational development.

## PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCES – DEVELOPMENT & POLICY ENGAGEMENTS; COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP & CIVIC RESPONSIBILITY



Mr. Niraj Kumar Singh's professional journey demonstrates a robust integration of policy research, development initiatives, and community leadership, reflecting a consistent focus on measurable social impact. Early in his career, he actively engaged in large-scale youth development programs, including the National Youth Corps Training Camp organized by Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (2016) and multiple Swachh Bharat initiatives through the NSS and RGNIYD (2017–2018). His roles in field-based interventions encompassed rural immersion programs in Puliur and Oragadam villages, community health and social sensitization campaigns in Rajasthan, and awareness initiatives for HIV/AIDS, education, and women's empowerment. These hands-on experiences were complemented by professional certifications in counseling, social work in mental health rehabilitation (NIMHANS, 2023), and research methodology with SPSS (RGNIYD, 2018), providing him with the analytical and operational skills necessary for effective program management.

As a Research Assistant at the University of Pennsylvania, he engaged in urban policy research, international development dialogues, and youth-focused policy frameworks, translating complex academic insights into actionable strategies for inclusive social transformation. During this period, he actively contributed to research on digital literacy, educational equity, and youth empowerment, culminating in accepted and presented papers at prestigious conferences, including CIES 2025 (Chicago), the Ethnography in Education Research Forum 2026 (Philadelphia), and the 5th Biennial Conference on Anthropology and Education, Teachers College, Columbia University (New York). Notable papers include "Transforming Education: Empowering Digital Literacy of Rural Youth from Bihar, India" and "Empowering Tribal Youth: Bridging Educational Gaps through Technology and Social Justice in Jharkhand, India", reflecting his expertise in applying research for tangible community impact.

As the Founder of Youthology International, Mr. Singh has built a transformative platform for youth empowerment, blending education, mental health, skill development, and social innovation. Through this initiative, he has conducted over 50 workshops and seminars, implemented cross-cultural projects, and led community-based programs, directly impacting more than 10,000 young people across India and internationally. His efforts emphasize resilience, creativity, and leadership, demonstrating how entrepreneurial innovation can drive measurable social transformation.
